








Rachel has produced outstanding work in both her examinations and her coursework. This has been consistent throughout the year.














# Art Emily Cullen

Kelly has shown commitment and effort to both theory and practical work in her lessons and in extra curricular commitments.




#### **Business Studies** Sarah Browne
