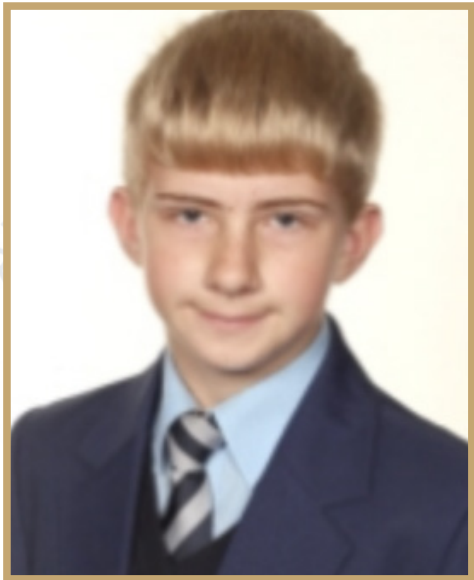

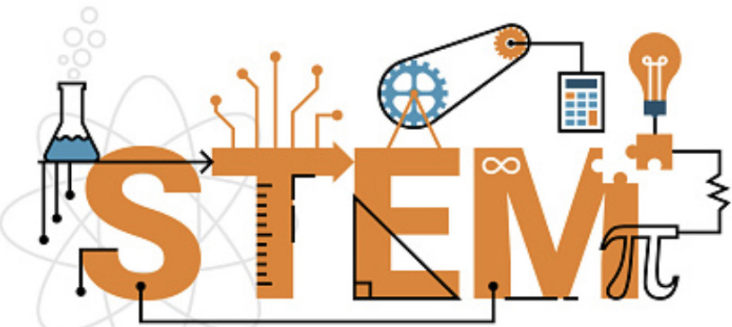

Always use "me" when it is the object OR after a preposition. For example: The drink was for my brother and me. The "drink" is the subject. "Me" is the object.

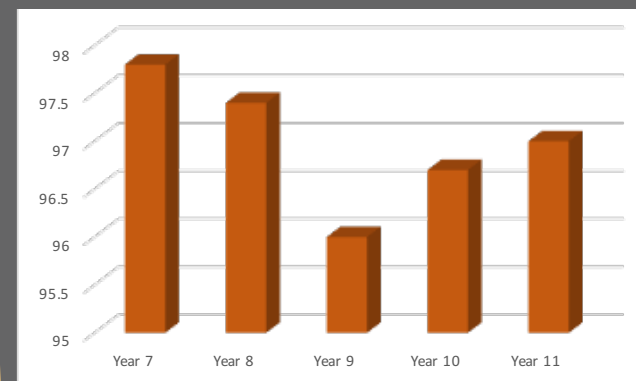

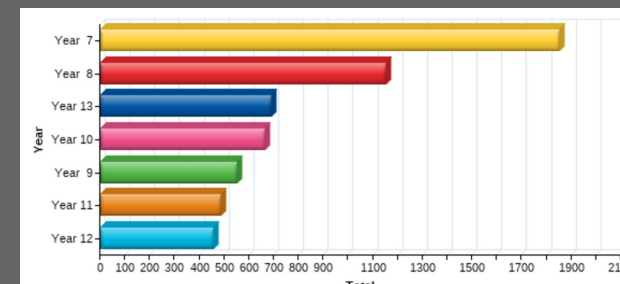
