Amen.*

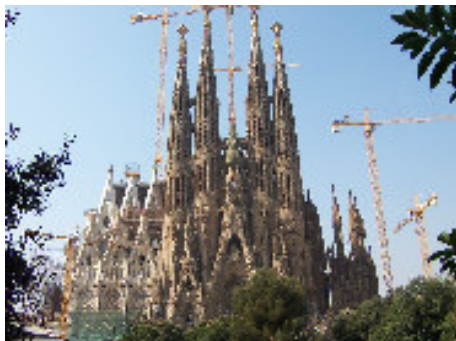
YEAR 10 VISIT TO BARCELONA AND THE COSTA BRAVA
