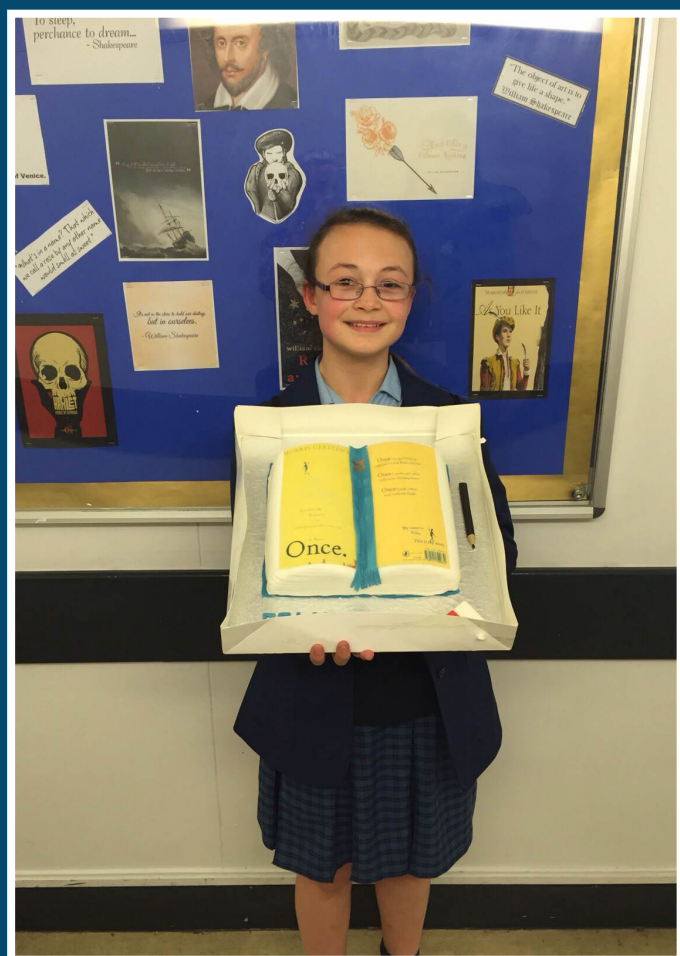

It is a club which encompasses Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths and offers loads of opportunities to get involved and do some fun things in these subjects that you would not normally do in class.

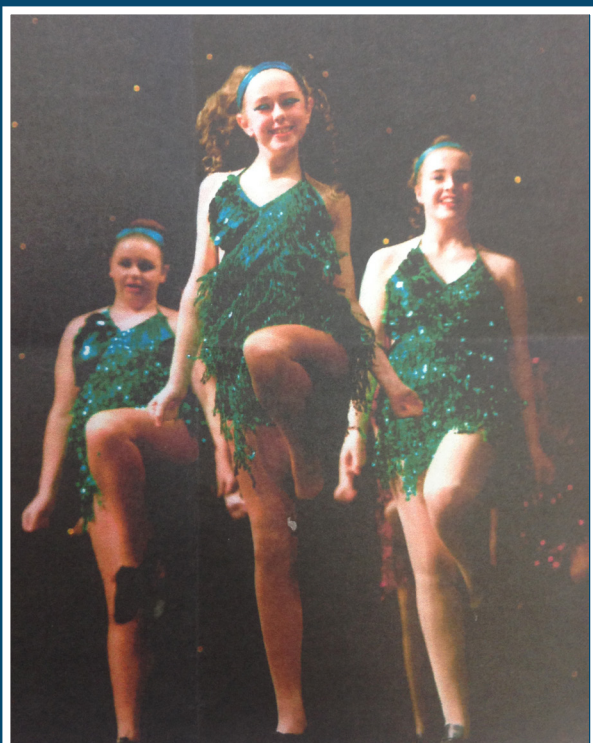
This LP we are:

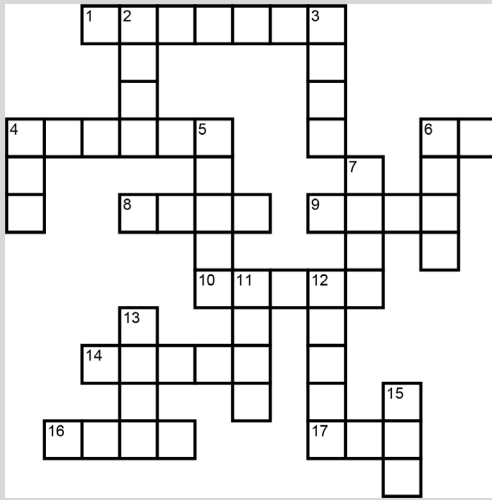
Year 7 Dancer

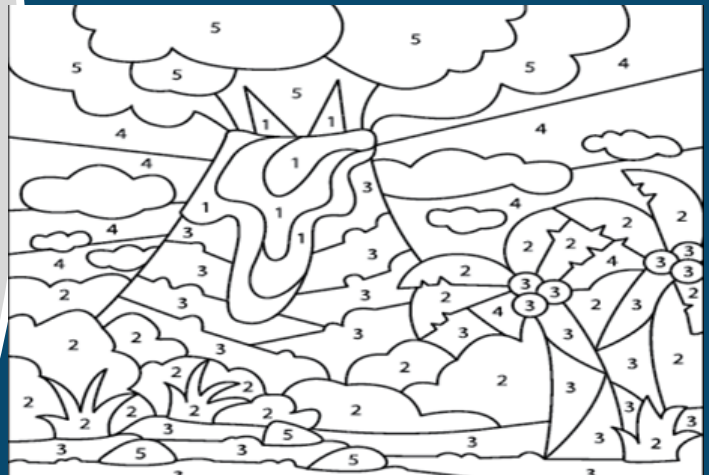

Languages Corner

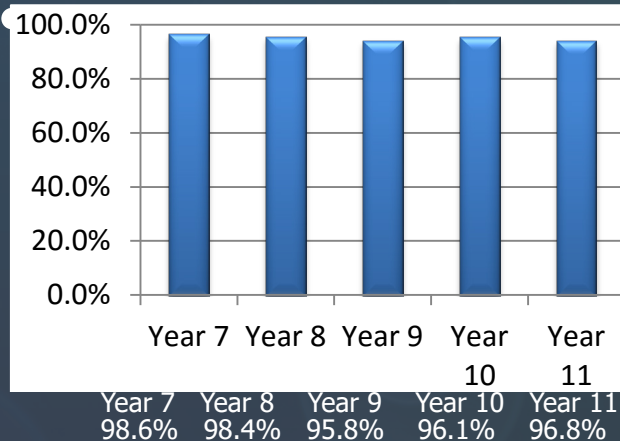

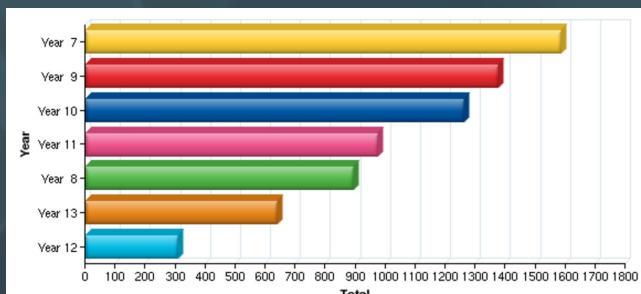
