



LANGUAGE CORNER

Machu Picchu, also known as the Lost City of the Incas is an Inca site in Peru that is thought to have been built as an estate for an Incan emperor. It was built in the 15th century, approximately around 1450. However, was abandoned as a place for Inca rulers at the end of the 16th century, supposedly due to an outbreak of smallpox from Spanish invaders. In Quechua, which is the language of the Incas, "Machu Picchu" means "Old Peak" or "Old Mountain."

Machu Picchu is made up of more than 150 buildings ranging from baths and houses to temples and sanctuaries. The compound contains more than 100 separate flights of stairs. Most of the individual staircases were carved from one slab of stone. Although many of the stones were extremely heavy, it is believed that no wheels were used to transport these rocks up the mountain. Rather, it is thought that hundreds of men pushed the heavy rocks up the steep mountain side.

It was discovered by the outside world in 1911and has since become Peru's main tourist attraction. Machu Picchu was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1983 and was named one of the New Seven Wonders of the World in 2007.

John 16:12-15

"I still have many things to tell you, but you can't handle them now. But when the Friend comes, the Spirit of the Truth, he will take you by the hand and guide you into all the truth there is. He won't draw attention to himself, but will make sense out of what is about to happen and, indeed, out of all that I have done and said. He will honour me; he will take from me and deliver it to you. Everything the Father has is also mine. That is why I've said, 'He takes from me and delivers to you.'
