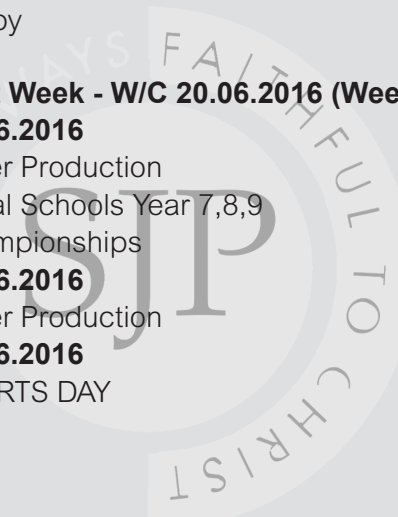

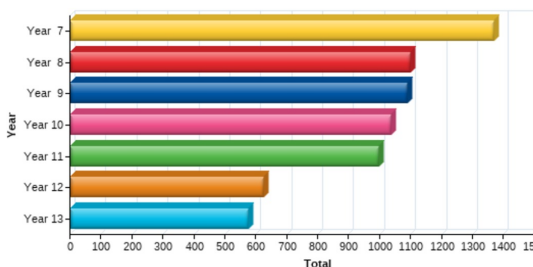

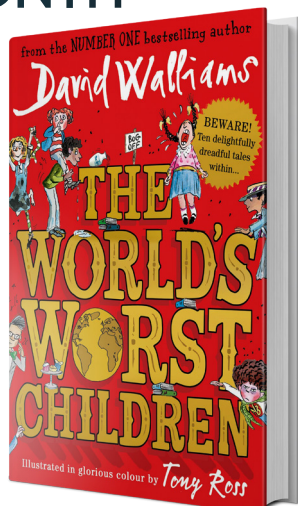
## YEAR 8 SCIENCE TRIP

The pupils were invited to an interactive lecture, where they listened to an explanation of what radiology is and how it can be used in lots of important medical and practical procedures. Afterwards there was an exhibition which demonstrated how radiology is helping people every day, and pupils were able to get hands-on experience with some very interesting and expensive equipment.

This event was a fantastic opportunity for pupils to develop their enthusiasm and interest in science, and to explore the uses of science in medicine and other areas. 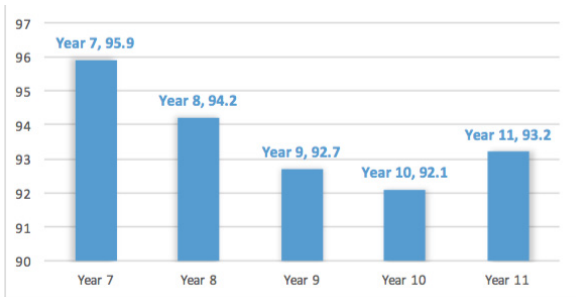
