
Safeguarding

The 'FREE BOOKS' for ALL Year 7 pupils is back again!


Now in its sixth year, this extremely popular campaign which is organised by Booktrust and funded by the Department for Education has given a free book to almost two million children in England.


The aim of the programme is to encourage and support reading for pleasure by providing **eve- ry** Year 7 pupil with a free book from the specially selected titles.

French fact of the fortnight


The French language does not naturally use the letter W. Any French words which do use the letter W have been borrowed from another language.



Weekly Theme - 'Who is Jesus'



Mark 8:27-35

Jesus and his disciples went on to the villages around Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked them, "Who do people sav I am?"

They replied, "Some say

John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, one of the prophets."

"But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" Peter answered, "You are the Messiah." Jesus warned them not to tell anyone about him. He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him.

But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. "Get behind me, Satan!" he said. "You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns."

Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and for the gospel will save it."

Ours is a Christian community, we believe that Jesus is the Christ (the Messiah) who was specially sent by God. When Jesus says to us 'Love one another', it is God himself who speaks to us.

As Members of the SJP Family, the Motto on our College Badge reads 'Faithful to Christ'. These shouldn't just be words on a badge, they should shape everything that we do both inside and outside college and how we interact and support each other. As we start the New school year perhaps it a good time to look at how well we are doing? Almighty God, our creator and guide, may we accept
