

Call into the Library and collect a **Reading Passport** to start travelling around the world collecting **Reading Miles** along the way.


Prizes will be awarded to everyone that completes the challenge.

Year 9 DofE Exhibition

Thirty three Y9 pupils completed their bronze Duke of Edinburgh practice expedition in North Wales this weekend.



On Friday afternoon they set off Llanarmon-yn-lal to camp overnight. This saw pupils develop skills in camp craft such as cooking using a trangia stove, setting up tents and planning for the following day. The completed these tasks under adverse weather conditions, but still managed to excel.

The following morning pupils were up very early (5am!) to organise their equipment, pack down the camp and review the route for the day ahead. They then completed a six hour trek, seeing them loop around challenging and beautiful terrain. This required pupils to develop skills in navigation, using ordinance survey map and compass.

Pupils worked well together to complete this challenging stage of the award, and look forward to undertaking their qualifying expedition in July. Well done Year 9!

School Direct is a one-year, full time teacher training programme. At SJP, all School Direct Associate Teachers (ATs) are allocated a dedicated subject mentor, and guided by specialist tutors. At the end of the year, successful ATs will qualify with QTS and PGCE, which is accredited by the University of Chester.

What are the entry requirements?

- UK university degree 2:1 or above (2:2 for Maths, Physics, Chemistry, MFL) or a recognised equivalent qualification - we also accept applications from final year students due to graduate in 2018 RE and Social Sciences.
- Grade C or above in GCSE **English and Mathematics** (Science for Primary)
- · At least two full days of school observation

You will be required to undergo an enhanced DBS check to verify your suitability to work with young people

What subjects do we offer?

We currently offer teacher training for Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Computer Science, DT, Drama, English, Geography, History, Maths, Media, Modern Foreign Languages, PE, Physics, Primary,

In addition, our School **Experience Programme offers** the opportunity to spend a day or two at SJP in your subject department. You will be able to observe classes taking place, engage with pupils, and speak to subject staff and the School Direct ATs who are currently training with us.

LP5 is now available to download

All pupils at SJP follow Learning Programmes in all subjects for a 7 week period of learning, which is then assessed. The LPs are available under the subject tabs on this section of the website for parents and pupils to access from home. They detail the programme of study for each subject, setting out the knowledge, skills and understanding you child will be taught. The Learning Programmes also signpost the assessment procedures including the homework that will be set each week.

To view a Learning Programme:

- 1. first select a subject you require
- 2. then select a Year group
- 3. then a flightpath/group
- 4. and finally the relevant Learning Programme.





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
