World Challenge preparation

Last weekend both World Challenge teams travelled to Snowdonia to complete their preparation for their adventure in Costa Rica in 2020.

All challengers braved a cold night, camping at the base of Snowdon and working together in their teams, they set up their own camps, cooked their own meals and navigated their way through woods and over a mountain in the National Park.

OVO Tour of Britain

On Wednesday 11th September PE staff took 70 students to watch stage 5 of the OVO Tour of Britain as it raced through Bebington.

Our students positioned themselves at the bottom of Heath road so they could feel the full impact of 90 professional cyclists ride by. The race started in Port Sunlight so when the cyclists reached us they had only been cycling for a short time but were already reaching speeds of 48 kmph

This particular stage was a fast and undulating 108 miles and saw the cyclists ride to all corners of the Wirral before crossing the finish line at Birkenhead Park.

A brief but exhilarating experience for our pupils that will last long in their memory.



On Thursday 12 September, 36 of our pupils set off to North Wales to begin their DofE Silver Award.

It was a good first day, however changing weather challenged pupils to effectively use their compasses to navigate in the mist. The second day in the country side was a much nicer experience with us reaching checkpoint 4, with pupils saying "its challenging but inspiring at the same time".

All pupils made the final leg to finish in Loggerhead. They had given everything over the last three days, showing skill, pure grit and determination

Their enthusiasm and teamwork are incredible and we are proud of their achievement.

This week we invite our Staff and Students to explore what it means to say "I am Sorry". Just how hard can it be to actually forgive someone who has hurt you and to move on.

Luke 15: 11-32 – The Forgiving Father
Jesus said, "There was once a man who
had two sons. The younger said to his
father, 'Father, I want right now what's
coming to me.' "So the father divided
the property between them. It wasn't
long before the younger son packed his
bags and left for a distant country. There,
undisciplined and dissipated, he wasted
everything he had. After he had gone
through all his money, there was a bad
famine all through that country and he
began to hurt. He signed on with a citizen there who assigned him to his fields
to slop the pigs. He was so hungry he

would have eaten the corncobs in the pig slop, but no one would give him any. "That brought him to his senses. He said, 'All those farmhands working for my father sit down to three meals a day, and here I am starving to death. I'm going back to my father. I'll say to him, Father, I've sinned against God, I've sinned before you; I don't deserve to be called your son. Take me on as a hired hand.' He got right up and went home to his father.

"When he was still a long way off, his father saw him. His heart pounding, he ran out, embraced him, and kissed him. The son started his speech: 'Father, I've sinned against God, I've sinned before you; I don't deserve to be called your son ever again.'

"But the father wasn't listening. He was calling to the servants, 'Quick. Bring a clean set of clothes and dress him. Put the family ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. Then get a grain-fed heifer and roast it. We're going to feast! We're going to have a wonderful time! My son is here given up for dead and now alive! Given up for lost and now found!' And they began to have a wonderful time.
